Make a cow puppet!

What you'll need for each puppet

- 12" x 20" white felt for puppet body
- 2 felt squares (1 pink, 1 black) for cow spots and face
- Black fine-tip permanent marker to draw mouth (optional)
- Fabric glue or hot glue gun/glue sticks
- Fabric shears, sewing machine, white thread

Directions

- Enlarge patterns 200% to match measurements.
- Cut 2 layers of white felt using main puppet shape pattern.
- Use suggested cow feature patterns provided here or cut 3 or 4 random "spots" plus 2 small circles for eyes from the black felt square.
- Using cow face pattern, cut 1 cow face and ears from the pink felt square.

Assembly instructions

- Place the cow front on top of the cow back, pinning if necessary.
- Sew along the edge of puppet using a 3/8" seam allowance and leaving the bottom open.
- Glue on spots, face and eyes. Use fabric marker to create desired facial features (nose, smiling mouth, etc.).
